Boost your leadership potential with an MBA in General Management. Combining theory with **real-world practice**, the program offers **hands-on learning** with experienced lecturers and strong industry connections, giving you the skills, experience, and professional network to **thrive** in today's fast-paced business world.

Our MBA program is taught entirely in English. Students have the option of enrolling full-time or part-time. The two programs differ only slightly.

If you choose the **part-time MBA**, your block seminars will take place once a month from Friday to Sunday in Dortmund. Additionally, you will spend three one-week study modules at renowned universities in the USA, India, and South Korea. As a **full-time MBA** student, you can cultivate and apply international management skills within a cultural setting during a study abroad program in Spain.

In addition, both **MBA programs** offer you the benefit of being guided by a **professional coach** throughout your studies. You will work on and improve your soft skills and optimize your leadership qualities.

Coaching — A Specific Highlight of Our MBA Program

Individual coaching is a key feature of the program. Each MBA student is mentored by a professional coach who helps **enhance leadership skills** and management qualifications. Our MBA coaching is divided into four phases. The results are summarized in a personal development report.

Phase 1

First, the coach and the student get to know each other and define their professional status through a standardized interview. This phase includes two sessions focused on identifying strengths and potential weaknesses, and defining development goals.

Phase 2

Phase 2 focuses on communication behavior. It is designed to improve your communication skills and behavior, including in an intercultural context.

Phase 3

The third phase aims to improve your team spirit and leadership skills. It includes an individual session and a full-day team seminar. In addition to that, career counseling is also part of phase 3.

Phase 4

Phase 4 primarily focuses on conflict management. The significance of maintaining a healthy work-life balance is also discussed. Another standardized interview is conducted to update your professional assessment.

Admission Requirements

In order to enroll in the MBA General Management at ISM, applicants must fulfill the following requirements:

- a first successful degree with 210 ECTS points from a university or an equivalent foreign higher education institution
- at least two years' professional experience after the first degree
- sufficient English language skills, e.g. TOEFL (at least 80 points internet-based) or IELTS (6.0 or better) or Cambridge (FCE)

Missing ECTS points may be replaced by qualified work experience up to a maximum of 30 ECTS points, in addition to the work experience required above.

Applicants who are subject to visa requirements must ensure that their application is submitted by the specified deadlines in the respective year.

Spring term: December 15th

Fall term: July 15th

Applicants without visa obligation or who already have a student visa may apply later.

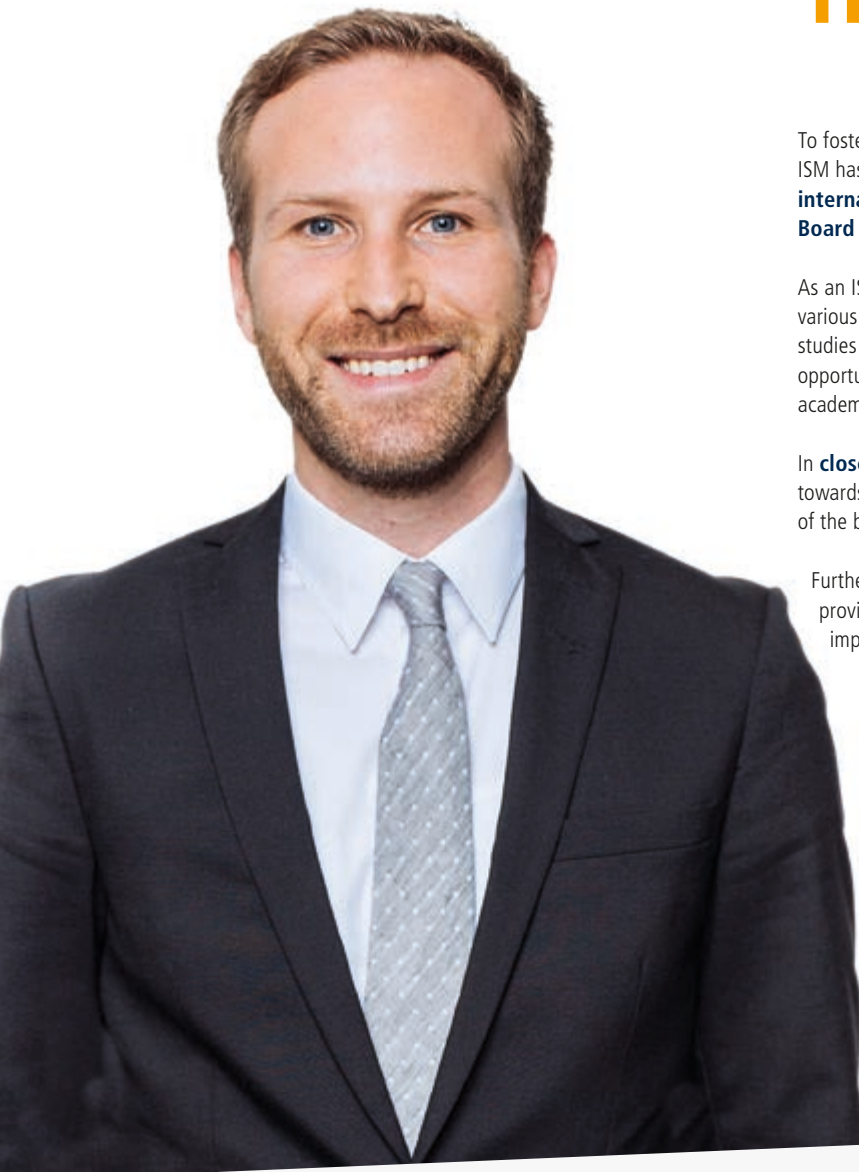

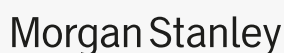
